- ◆ All assistance and events are provided at no cost to Veterans and their families



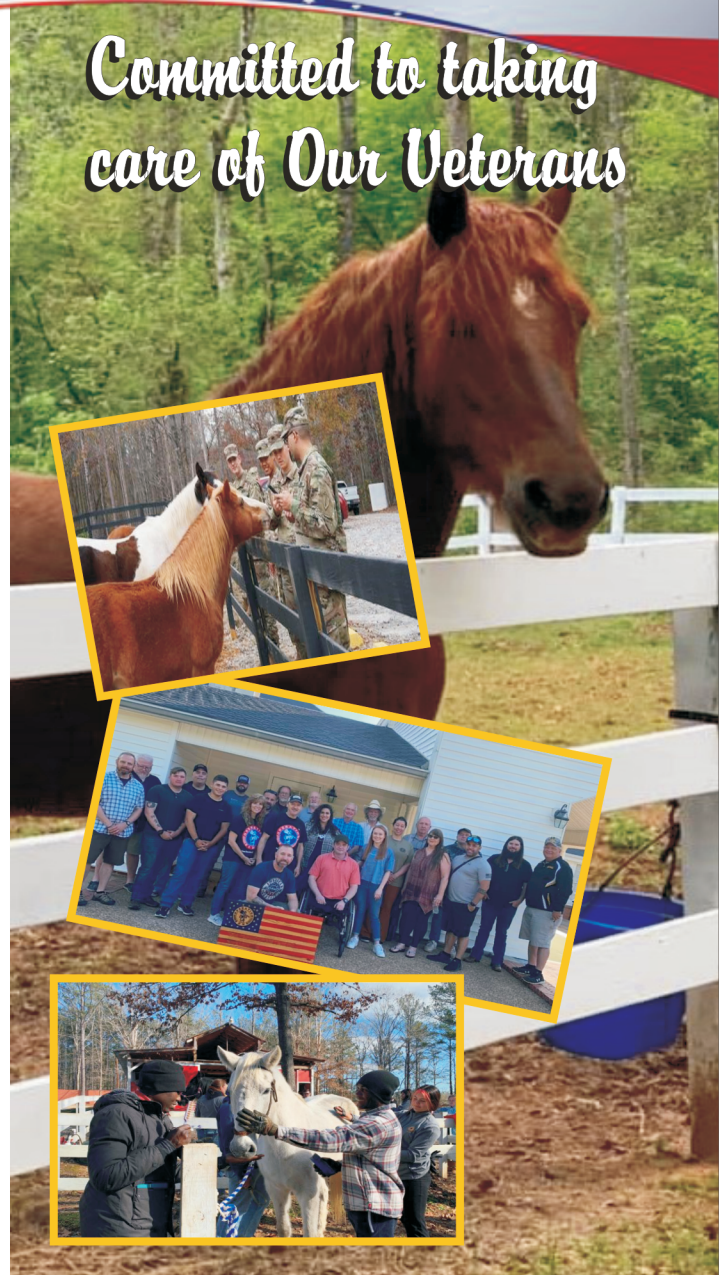

Equine Program



Our Equine program serves as a platform, that encourages and promotes good physical and mental health of Veterans and their Families.

We incorporate the principles of equine therapy to enhance positive character traits, such as patience, discipline, understanding, empathy and self-control.

Horse back riding stimulates positive psychological feelings and develops confidence and self-esteem.

We have trained instructors and willing volunteers that assist us with the operation of the program.

Food Distribution Program



We host multiple food drives monthly providing Veterans in need with essential supplies and food.

We partner with Feeding The Valley Food bank and Volunteers to make this program possible

Together over 10,000 families in the community benefitted from our bi-monthly sale drive-thru distribution program.

Veterans helping Veterans



The Veterans helping Veterans is a program that assist Veterans, Gold Star Moms, widows and other members of our community when

in need of essential services, i.e., home repairs, and any kind of manual labor.

We also provide care packages containing essential supplies for our deployed Service Members.

Operation Song
